FIRE OFFICIALS REPORT MAY 2013 Fire District No.4

The Bureau investigated a compliant at 388 New Brunswick Ave Apt.2 after the fire department responded to a report of an gas odor in side of the apartment. After an investigation it was determined that the hardwired smoke alarms that were inside of the apartment were not operating on the buildings electric and had missing backup batteries.

The landlord was cited and ordered to repair or replace the smoke/co detectors in the 2nd floor apartment. The landlord had his licensed electrician on location with in 1 hour and replaced all of the detectors.

The Bureau also notified the Woodbridge Township Housing Bureau due to the building being a two family house. I could not gain access to the apartment on the first floor to determine the status of the alarms inside of that apartment. The Township Housing inspector arrived later that afternoon and followed up on the 1st floor apartment and resident other housing complaints.

The Dana Bio-Diesel Plant is still before the Woodbridge Township Technical Review Committee. As of this writing I have not heard back from the applicants Engineer regarding the water system.

I will keep the Board advised as I receive any information.
