Minutes of the Fire District No.4, Agenda Meeting of March 8th, 2022


The March 8th, 2022 agenda meeting was opened by President Dwayne Jensen, commissioners in attendance were Klose, Pawol, Hughes, and Krejci. The two accountants and attorney were not present or required to attend this meeting. The pledge of allegiance was said followed by a moment of silence.

Agenda Discussion:

- 1.) Went over the building sketch for the possible relocation of the firehouse from 420 Smith, and rebuilding at 177 & 199 Smith Street.
- 2.) Two Commissioners will meet with Mr. Robbie Conley Architect, LLC to discuss a few changes to the plans or drawings for the firehouse relocation.
- 3.) Contacted the Mayor, concerning the time frame for the residents of 199 Smith Street to vacate the property, no longer than 2-3 years, so the two homes can be torn down, and provide additional parking spaces.
- 4.) A representative from EcolSciences, Inc. will be doing a site inspection of the firehouse, and property on 3/11/22 to see if there are any underground fuel storage tanks buried on the firehouse property, they have been retained by Stalwart Equities, to conduct an environmental assessment and inspection of 420 Smith St.
- 5.) New Jersey Civil Service Certification Disposition for OL210675.

Motion to adjourn, Jensen, seconded by Klose, all were in favor, meeting adjourned at 8:20 P.M.
