SHALL THE COMMISSIONERS OF FIRE DISTRICT NO. 4, IN WOODBRIDGE TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, BE AUTHORIZED TO ACQUIRE A NEW AERIAL FIRE TRUCK TO REPLACE A 1972 MACK FIRE TRUCK, FOR A SUM OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,360,000? THIS ACQUISITION WOULD BE FUNDED BY EITHER A LEASE PURCHASE OR BY OTHER AUTHORIZED METHODS, WITH A \$525,000 DOWN PAYMENT PROVIDED BY EXISTING UNRESTRICTED RESERVE FUNDS AND THE BALANCE TO BE APPROPRIATED IN FUTURE BUDGETS?
