
Swearing In Ceremony

Resolution No. 2022- 12  
RESOLUTION APPOINTING CAREER FIREFIGHTERS

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District No.4, Township of Woodbridge, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey, has created the paid position of career firefighter pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-81.1;and

WHEREAS, the Board finds and determines that the present personnel should be increased by three (3) career firefighters so as to provide effective and efficient fire service to the District; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Woodbridge is a Civil Service jurisdiction and therefore any paid position in the career service shall be determined pursuant to ranking established by the New Jersey Civil Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined in accordance with Civil Service rules and regulations that the hereinafter set forth firefighters have fulfilled all Civil Service requirements, Township ordinances, and Boards fit for duty background check, physical examinations, drug testing, and satisfied the personnel committee of their respective qualifications; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the District that the three (3) candidates for the paid position of career firefighter be hired to fulfill the Districts current needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No. 4, Township of Woodbridge, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey, that the following firefighters be hired full-time and be subject to all terms and conditions set forth by the Board:

2. Dylan L Schelmety
3. Devin L Schelmety

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the within Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage with the above-named individuals initial date of employment commencing on September 6<sup>st</sup>, 2022.
