Agenda Discussion:

- 1.) The storage shed roof is leaking, shingles are missing, and the plywood is rotting, a temporary repair will be done sometime next week.
- 2.) The redevelopment of Smith Street and the fire house property for a planned warehouse building, updated news from the developer Stalwart, is trying to purchase 177 Smith Street, for a future firehouse location, also the owner of 199 won't give up there two rental houses.
- 3.) We are making progress with the hiring of three fulltime firefighters, Woodbridge P.D. going over there back ground checks, driving records, should be setting up interviews shortly.
- 4.) William Krejci, is in the process of getting price quotes for (2) sawzall battery powered tools.
- 5.) One Fire Commissioner will be moving out of state in July, and a temporary Commissioner will take his place on the Board until the next election in February 2023.
