Fire & Safety was contacted to have all fire apparatus serviced at there shop, they will pickup & deliver the trucks and engines with there employees.

The fire company will fuel up all fire apparatus as of now, and they will be compensated at the end of the year for there services.

Tower ladder 424 will have it's aerial tested on March 2nd, 2010 at 8:00am. Old Business:

Mr. Jensen reported that Jensen landscaping repaired most of the roof leaks, with rolled roofing and tarring.

Mr. Jensen reported that the explorer program is up and running, they were issued pagers, and Mr. Tom Barry will be in charge of there training.
