Dana Trucking has received the approval from the Planning Board for the Bio Diesel Plant located on Smith Street.


The have been working with Middlesex Water to improve the water system on the property.

The plans were approved by the Township on September 19th.

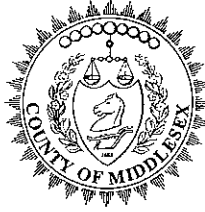
I will keep the Board updated as I get more information on this project.
